

Major Question

Do you have a class with MIXED Japanese skills?

High-Middle-Low achiever...

Before: Hit the MIDDLE model



But.. this model excludes

$$\frac{5+5}{25} = 40\%$$

Into students' shoes

When do YOU get disengaged?

In my case,

- 1) Too hard or too easy
- 2) Not user friendly (eg: insurance policy)
 - *We all look for USEFUL info

Solution: Do the opposite!!

- *DIFFERENTIATE to meet as many kids' level
- *VISUALIZE your lesson, not talking

Next question

HOW we can differentiate and visualize our lessons?

AVOID

X Too many lesson plans

X Management problem, not supervised

Answer: Blended Learning

COMBINE

Direct Teaching (by Teacher)

AND

Engaging Technology

Step 1: Structure your unit

We teach every unit with the exact same lesson sequence

Benefit

For teacher: Simplify lesson plan making

For students: Avoid confusion

No more "What are we doing today???"

UNIT Sequence

1: Repeat	2: GOOGLE VIDEO
3: TICK	4: Q FLASH
5: WORD ATTACK	6: Q MATCH
7: Q LIVE	8: Q Test
9:MOCK	10: Q ANY
11: Test	12: HIRAGANA

Step 2: Split the class by level

PLACEMENT TEST

Announce in week 1 and test in week 9-10

eg: Beginner and Intermediate

Step 2: Split the class by level

Teach Beginner and Intermediate every other lesson

How?

Direct teaching and computer: Back and forth

Share unit sequence to kids all the time

Structure 3: Divide the 50 mins

Step 4: Set up the room (front)

Step 5: Direct teaching (front) = Release of responsibility
